**B** - This is given to a student who is working above their level. Generally it is given if they are achieving the expected outcomes of the year or 2 above. This is a very good result.

**A** - This is given to students who are working well above what is expected **and** can apply that knowledge to a variety of different circumstances and situations, both in and out of context. A's are very difficult to receive.

**D** - Students who receive a D are working slightly lower than what is expected.

**E** - These students are usually accessing a modified curriculum to enable them to achieve growth. They are working below stage expectations.

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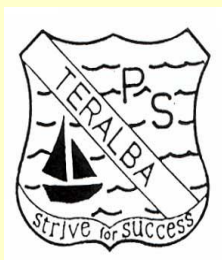
