Book Week Parade and assembly will be held in the library on Tuesday 21st August. Children are asked to come dressed as their favourite story book characters.

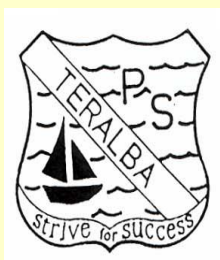
