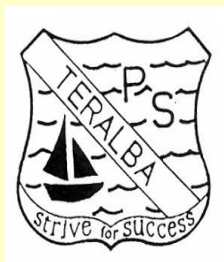

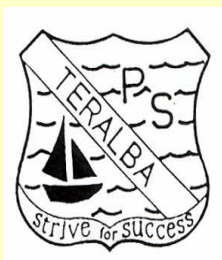

A huge thank you goes to Bianca, Suzanne, Karen and Yvonne for the roles that they played in the night, as well as the other parents that helped.

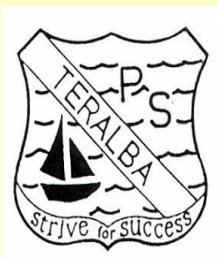
With the success of that evening we will plan some more discos in the future.
